# WIRE ANTENNAS UK <br> GOING THE EXTRA MILE 

## 80 / 40 instructions follow

Balun feed point to 40 m trap 10.05 meters / 33 feet
40 m trap to end 5.57 meters / 18 feet 3 inches leave the wire long and Check swr on highest band first. the bandwidth will be fairly flat on 40 m . When you are happy with that move on to 80 m and so on. To provide some adjustment on 80 m leave the wire about a foot long and fold it back on itself. secure with cable ties. I have tested the traps for dip at the appropriate points. Note dipole tested at height of $8-10 \mathrm{~m}$ height and in inverted V configuration. Ends 8 ft of the ground. At your QTH lengths may vary. Use insulated wire and any problems don't hesitate to ask. . I use flexweave, which is expensive. So I leave it plenty long and then trim. I use an antenna analyser which is very time saving, but it is possible to do without. Band centers are 7.150 and 3.700 Mhz
